

Event Centre

There will be no event centre. For shelter use WTOC centre hotel Cieplice.

TempO situation plan



Registration desk

On the way to the start. There you can pay your entry fee and pick up your bibs. Registration desk starts working at 9:30.

Terrain

Granite stones, rock formations, clean forest-like park, paved flat path. Similar to WTOC terrains. Entering the terrain before the competition means disqualification. Competition area is a private property and you may have problems with an owner or local authorities.

Course

6 stations, 5 tasks at each one.
Total course length 600 m

Distances

Hotel Cieplice (WTOC centre) - registration desk	1300 m
Suggested parking - registration desk	500 m
Registration desk - start	300 m
Registration desk - end of the course	700 m

Zero Tolerance

4 metres or another mapped point object

Assistance

Will not be provided by organiser. Take your own assistance.

Start list

Available on the website. Please, follow it as much as you can. In fact, you can start anytime during the race is on, but if you won't follow your start time and there will be queue on the start, you have to wait until there will be an empty timespot. Competitors starting in their own start time has always a priority.

Bib numbers

No competitor can compete without their bib. Bibs are to take at the registration desk and will be used for Sunday PreO race as well.

Toilets

Use toilets in hotel Cieplice. On the path to start there is one Handicap ToiToi Cabine.

Workflow of the race

You as competitor come to the start by marked path. The path will be marked from suggested parking by blue-white stripes. It is forbidden to use the road to Dąbrówka from the east. In Dąbrówka there is no place for parking, the road is very narrow and you would be disqualified.

At the registration desk you pick up your answer cards and bibs and attach it visibly somewhere at your clothes/wheelchair.

On the start there is a flag "Start" and the STOP signal. Wait there for calling from referee on Station 1.

Procedure will be the same as usual, referee shows you the kites and starts measuring your time.

After you finish the station, referee send you to the next one.

After all the stations are done, competitor use the same way as he come (through competition area) to return. Keep quiet, for talk you will have the rest of the day.

Protests and complaints

For technical issues and complaints the Adviser is available at the last TempO station. There you can tell him, what was wrong. Official protest time starts right after the last competitor finish his race and it lasts for 15 minutes. Fee for given protest is 10 EUR.


Event Centre

There will be no event centre.

Parking

Parking next to the city cemetery (50.8933947N, 15.7471689E). In case of fullfill the parking use the next parking by the hotel Mercure.

Registration desk

Works only on Saturday TempO race. If you participate only on the PreO, we manage it at the SI read out spot.

Terrain

Forest-like city park, many asphalt paths, rideable elevations, contour shapes, few granite stones.

Course

27 controls, 2 TC after the course, length 1.6 km, 40m climbing.

There will be a One-Way after the 4th control. After you step over the tape, you are not allowed to return back. Don't forget to punch all controls before you move to the one way!

Caution - There is plenty of paths in the competition area. Read the map carefully to understand, where you can/can't go. Only the most important places/junctions will be marked in terrain!

Some of the paths has stairs on them as well. It is allowed to go and stop under/on the top of these stairs, but it is **forbidden to use them!** They won't be marked in the terrain.

Limit

Elite Open, Elite Junior, A - 129 minutes

Elite Para - 144 minutes

Map

Kościuszki, 1:4000, E 2m, printed on plastic paper (waterproof), A5 size

Recording system

SportIDENT, each competitor needs own SCard (it can be borrowed from organiser at the start)

Start

00 = 10:00

Distances

Parking - start 300m / 20m climbing

Parking - finish (SI-read out) 650m / 10m climbing

Zero Tolerance

4 metres or another mapped point object

Bib numbers

Use your bibs from TempO race. If you don't participate the TempO, your bib will wait for you at the start.

Assistance

Will not be provided by organiser. Take your own assistance. You will need it in case you have no additional motor on your wheelchair.

Toilets

Before the start there is one ToiToi Handicap Cabine. The same one is at the end of the course in the finish.

Start list

Available on the website. Please, follow it as much as you can. In fact, you can start anytime during the race is on, but there may be a problem with a queue before the TC when many competitors start at once.

Workflow of the race

You as competitor come to the start by marked path. The path will be marked from parking by blue-white stripes. There is a quite big climbing to the Start (20m), so please, if you can, help wheelchair competitors without assistance to get there.

On the start you clear your SI chip, take the map and punch the SIunit START. Then do your job on the course. When you reach the finish, don't forget to punch the SIunit FINISH.

Close to the finish there is a ToiToi Cabine.

After that you follow the signs to time controls (steep asphalt uphill), where you stop at the STOP sign and wait for referee signal. TCs are close together.

After the 2nd TC you read out your SCard and your race is over. Until the last competitor starts we take your map from you (all collected maps will be available at the WTOC Model race, where you can pick them up).

Then you quietly leave the competition area to parking by the shortest possible way. Don't observe controls, don't disturb other competitors.

Protests and complains

For technical issues and complaints the Adviser is available at the last time control. There you can tell him, what was wrong and if it is necessary, handle it there. Official protest time starts right after the last competitor finish his race and it last for 15 minutes. Fee for given protest is 10 EUR.
