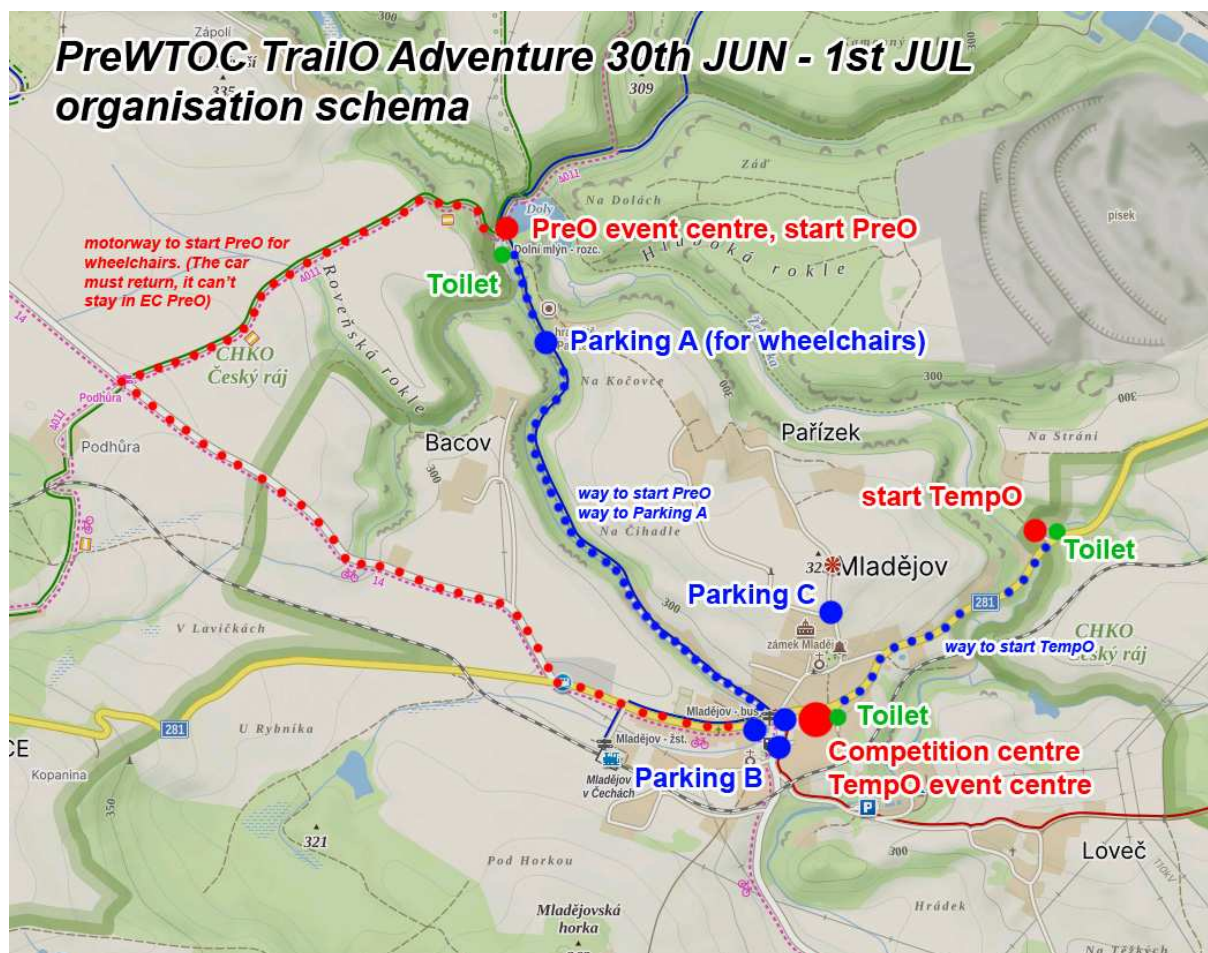

Restaurant "Mladějovská formanka", 50.4819200N, 15.2341081E

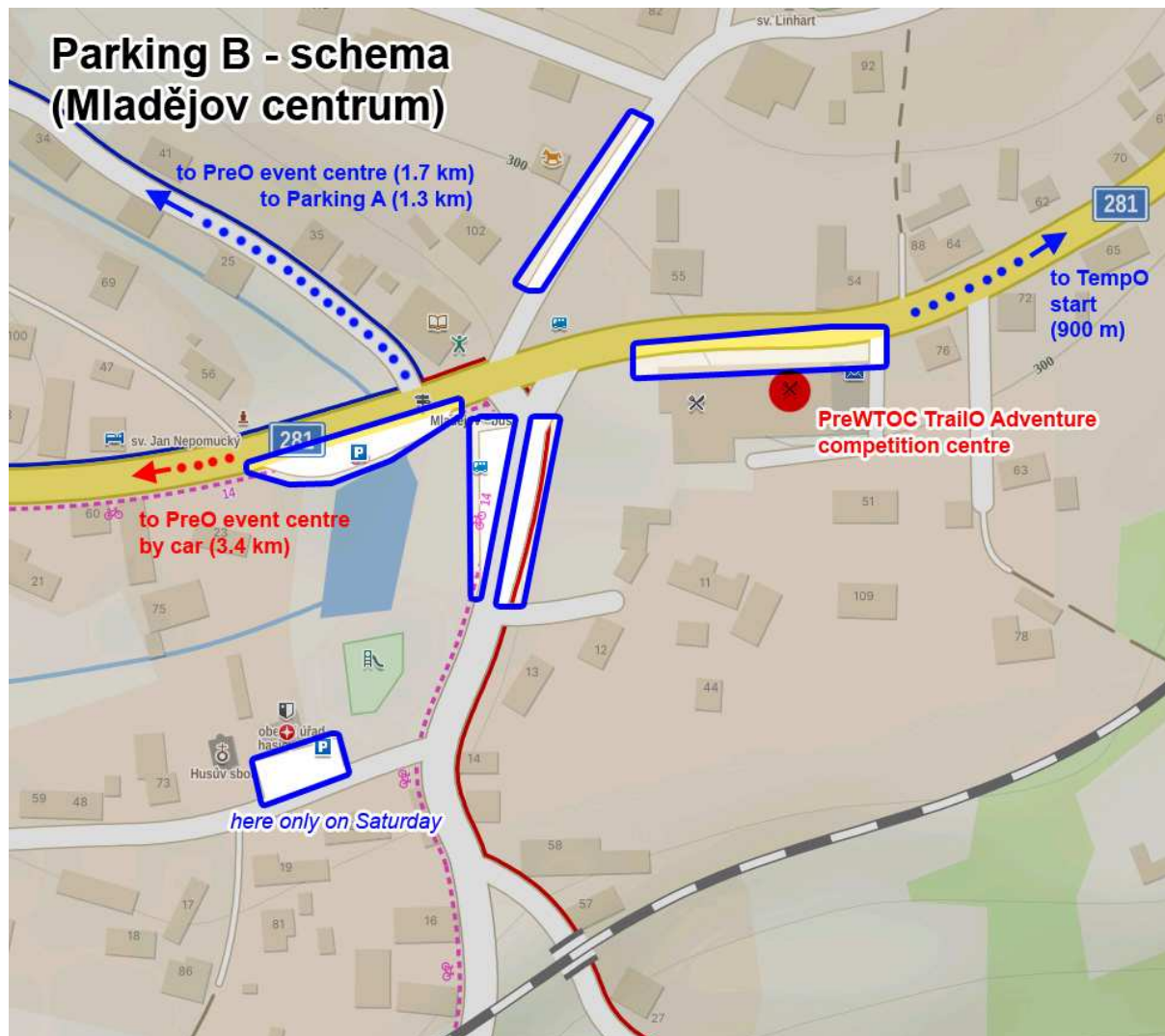
There is a large hall, wheelchair toilet, good meals and drinks.

Parking

There are prepared three parking places (see map above):

parking A - 50.4906031N, 15.2242642E, close to PreO event centre. It is a meadow, unpaved, accessible by car only in good weather. In case of heavy rain before the competition, this parking will be inaccessible and closed.

parking B - public parking in the centre of Mladějov (see the picture below, available parking is marked by blue boxes), all paved. Could be occupied by tourists and other visitors of Mladějov. Capacity should be sufficient. Follow the road signs and don't park at the bus station.



parking C – behind the local cemetery. Park on the edge of the narrow asphalt road, let other vehicles pass around you. It's the highest point of Mladějov = not so suitable for wheelchairs.

PreO - 30th June

Event Centre

Dike of pond "Doly", 50.4934458N, 15.2225100E.

No organiser will be at the competition centre in Mladějov this day! But the restaurant is open, you can visit it after the race for the refreshment!

Registration desk

Operating all day at the event centre. You can pay your entry fee there and pick up your starting bibs. Registration opens at 8:30.

Terrain

Sandstone rock formations, clear forest, good visibility

Course

27 controls, 1 TC before the course, length 600 m, 8 m climbing.
A-class has no Zero answers on the course (except tasks A-Z).

Limit

Elite Open, Elite Junior, A - 99 minutes
Elite Para - 110 minutes

Map

Doly, 1:3 000, E 2m, printed on waterproof paper, size A4

Recording system

SportIDENT, each competitor needs own SCard (it can be borrowed from the organiser at the registration desk, please return it right after the SI-ReadOut)

Start

00 = 09:00

Distances

Competition centre - Event centre (on foot) 1700 m / -30 m climbing
600 m asphalt, the rest is footpath on meadow, unpaved.

Competition centre - Event centre (by car) 3400 m
2,1 km asphalt, the rest is a gravel road with steep downhill at the end. **The car CANNOT stay at the event centre.** You can drive there, drop off other passengers, and return to Mladějov.

Parking A - Event centre	350 m
Parking B - Event centre	1700 m (marked by signs)
Parking C - Event centre	2100 m
Event centre - start	100 m
Event centre - finish	700 m

Zero Tolerance

4 metres

Bib numbers

Will be available at the event centre by self-service (bibs will hang on a rope near the registration desk). These bibs will be used for Tempo too. Please attach it visibly somewhere to your clothes/wheelchair. Without bib number you would not be allowed to start.

Assistance

Assistance will not be provided by organiser. Bring your own assistance. The course road is very good, no bumps, no roots, etc. But assistance is strongly recommended for the section from the competition centre to the event centre in case you have no additional motor on your wheelchair.

Toilets

Before the start of the competition there will be two toilets for wheelchair users. Another wheelchair toilets are next to the competition centre, and also inside the restaurant.

Start list

Start list is available on the website. **Please, be thoughtful and follow it as much as possible.** In fact, you can start anytime during the race, but there may be a queue before the TC when many competitors want to start at once.

Race organisation

Competitors come to the start by marked path. The path will be marked from parking B with TrailO signs.

The race begins with a time control. After the time control, the competitors need to clear their SI, punch SI unit "START" and then they are given a map. At the end of the race, don't forget to punch the SI unit "FINISH".

After that the competitors return same way back to the event centre. Please, do not disturb other competitors by observing the controls, chatting with your friend etc. There you read-out your SI and the race is over.

Protests and complaints

For technical issues and complaints, the Adviser is available in the event centre. He is available to discuss any issues with the course. If necessary, you can make an official written complaint and give to the adviser or the organiser. Please, do it as soon as possible so we can handle the complaints in the meantime. The official time for complaints ends 15 minutes after the last starting competitor returns to the event centre.

Fee for submitting the protest is 50 EUR.

The final score will be counted as: TempO race + TC PreO race + 90 seconds penalty for every PreO mistake.

Solutions

Will be available at the event centre after the last competitor finishes the race, or on Saturday in competition centre. And, of course, in digital form at the website.

Other - PreO training during TempO race

We leave almost all controls from PreO race (maybe the last one or two will be taken for TempO race) in the forest till the end of TempO race on Saturday. It is for training purpose, maybe some of you could find it interesting and can spare the time during waiting for prizegiving ceremony by something useful ;).

TempO - 1st July

Event Centre

The same as the competition centre, it opens at 8:00.

Registration desk

Registration desk is in the competition centre, and it operates from circa 9:00 and remains open for the rest of the day.

Terrain

Sandstone rock formations, clear forest, large clearings, excellent visibility

Course

7 stations, 5 tasks at each one

Total course length 700 m

Map

1:3000, E 2m

Recording system

PreOr TempO Station system

Start

00 = 09:00

Distances

Competition centre - parking B 0-200 m

Competition centre - parking C 400 m

Competition centre - start 900 m / -30 m, using the 2nd class asphalt road with busy traffic. **Be very careful and pay attention to cars!**

Zero Tolerance

4 metres

Assistance

Will not be provided by the organiser. Bring your own assistance, it will be useful on the way back to the competition centre (30 m uphill).

Start list

Start list is available on the website. **Please, be thoughtful and follow it as much as possible.** In fact, you can start anytime during the race, but there may be a queue before the TC when many competitors want to start at once.

Bib numbers

No competitor can compete without their bib. The competitors should have their bibs from PreO race. Those who compete only in TempO, will find their bibs at the registration desk.

Toilets

Before the start of the competition there will be one toilet for wheelchair users. Another wheelchair toilets are next to the competition centre, and also inside the restaurant.

Race organisation

All competitors must pick up their answer cards at the registration desk. Then they go to the start following the main asphalt route (it won't be marked, but you can't miss it). On the starting point of the race, there is a flag "Start" and the STOP sign. Wait there until the referee from Station 1 calls you.

The procedure will be same as usual - the referee shows the competitor the flags and starts measuring their time. If you want to point the answer instead of speak, let the referee know in advance! After finishing the station, the referee will send the competitor to the next one. When all the stations are completed, the competitor uses the same way as he came (through competition area) to return. Please, keep quiet and do not disturb other competitors.

Protests and complaints

For technical issues and complaints, the Adviser is available in the competition centre or on the TempoO course. He is available to discuss any issues with the course. If necessary, you can make an official written complaint and give to the adviser or the organiser. Please, do it as soon as possible so we can handle the complaints in the meantime. The official time for complaints ends 15 minutes after the last starting competitor returns to the event centre.

Fee for given protest is 50 EUR.
